Invited Speaker: Mr. Frank Busalacchi, Secretary Wisconsin Department of Transportation

Topic of Discussion: "The Marquette Interchange Project: Building it Right"

About the speaker: In January of 2003, Frank Busalacchi was named secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation by Governor Jim Doyle. Secretary Busalacchi was formerly the secretary-treasurer of Teamsters Local 200 based in Milwaukee, one of the largest Teamster locals in the state.

Mr. Busalacchi, who lives with his wife and family in Brookfield, has done much to build up Milwaukee and southeast Wisconsin. He served as president of the Summerfest Board of Directors and chair of the negotiating committee responsible for the lease between Milwaukee World Festivals and the city of Milwaukee. He also served as the construction committee chairman for the Miller Park Baseball Stadium construction project. He was a member of the Southeast Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission advisory committee to the southeast freeway study and a member of the Greater Milwaukee Committee.

As secretary of Wisconsin DOT, Mr. Busalacchi leads one of the largest state agencies with over 3,800 employees and dozens of satellite and district offices. WisDOT's annual budget of over \$2 billion includes support for all modes of transportation, including state highways, local roads, railroads, public transit systems, airports, harbors and bicycle and pedestrian facilities.
